#### 3.1 About BEML LIMITED.

#### **INTRODUCTION:**

- **3.1.1** BEML Limited (formerly Bharat Earth Movers Limited), a Schedule 'A" company under the Ministry of Defence (MoD), Government of India was established in the year 1964. BEML is a listed company wherein the Government of India holds 54% of its equity & has state-of-the-art, well-established, and dedicated Research & Development, Product Design, Manufacturing Facilities, Assembly Shops for Equipment and Aggregates, Testing facilities, etc. The Company is backed with strong and well-experienced skilled manpower in the areas of Defence & Aerospace, Mining & Construction, and Rail & Metro equipment. The turnover of the Company is around Rs 4000 crores.

#### **OBJECTIVES OF THE EoI:**

3.2.1 This Expression of Interest (EoI) seeks responses from the Prospective Collaborator that are willing to be associated with BEML through Strategic Tie-ups/long-term business collaboration for "design, design validation, development, manufacture, testing, installation, commissioning including trials and after-sales





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service of Sea Borne Aircraft Arresting Gear and other electro-hydraulic equipment such as Aircraft Restraining Gear, Missile / Torpedo Launchers, Ship / Submarine based Masts, Aircraft Lifts on Ship Decks, land and ship based Aircraft Arrester Barrier Systems, etc. primarily for Indian Naval Ships and Submarines or any other customer. The IPR for the Indigenous design(s) developed through the proposed strategic tie-up will be held with BEML Limited.

#### **SECTION - 4**

#### SCOPE OF THE STRATEGIC TIE-UP / LONG-TERM COLLABORATION

- 4.1 The scope of strategic tie-up /collaboration between BEML and Prospective Collaborator shall include the following but not limited to: -
  - (a) Assist BEML in the indigenous development of Arresting Gears fitted onboard Aircraft Carrier/Shore-based facilities under Chapter IV of DAP 2020 and based on SQRs /SOTRs issued by the Indian Navy. The equipment(s) designed should qualify for procurement under the Buy (Indian IDDM) category of Chapter I of DAP 2020.
  - (b) Assist BEML in the validation of Sea Borne Aircraft Arresting Gear design through reputed Indian/ Foreign experts or design agencies, as applicable. The aforesaid reputed expert/ agency should have experience in the proven design of similar equipment.
  - (c) Assist BEML in preparation of a Feasibility Study Report (FSR) for indigenous development of Sea Borne Aircraft Arresting Gear based on SQRs / SOTRs issued by the Customer and in accordance with Chapter III/ IV of DAP 2020. The FSR should inter alia identify and recommend proposed production partners, if any.
  - (d) Assist BEML in the production of Prototype Arresting Gear and Prototype Testing including Type Testing and requisite Factory and Field Acceptance Trials.
  - (e) Assist BEML in Obtaining requisite regulatory approvals for the indigenised Arresting Gear.
  - (f) Assist BEML in the Installation and Commissioning of the Arresting Gear on Indian Naval Aircraft Carrier(s) / Shore-based facility, as applicable.





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- (g) Assist BEML in providing spare parts & maintenance, training, upgrades, warranty, and other support services for the Arresting Gear till the end of its service life.
- (h) Assist BEML in indigenous design and development of other electro-hydraulic equipment such as Aircraft Restraining Gear, Missile / Torpedo Launchers, Ship / Submarine based Masts, Aircraft Lifts on Ship Decks, land and ship-based Aircraft Arrester Barrier Systems, etc based on SQRs / SOTRs issued by the Customer.
- 4.2 A separate teaming agreement would be concluded with the selected Prospective Collaborator, on case-to-case basis, towards indigenous design, development and production of each of the above-mentioned equipment.





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#### **SECTION - 5**

#### **ELIGIBILITY CRITERIA:**

The following are the mandatory conditions to be fulfilled by the Prospective Collaborator for responding to the Eol.

- 5.1 The interested Prospective Collaborator must be registered in India as required by law with a minimum of **ten (10) years** of continuous operation up to the date of publication of this EoI.
- 5.2 The interested Prospective Collaborator should have experience of a minimum of **Ten (10) years** in the manufacture/ supply/ installation/ testing of Hydraulic Systems/ Electro-Mechanical Structures/ Assemblies / sub-assemblies/ Launchers for Naval and/ or Merchant Platforms up to the date of publication of this Eol.
- 5.3 The interested Prospective Collaborator should have its own captive functional manufacturing facility and/ or be in operation for a minimum period of **ten (10) years** in the manufacture and/or supply and/ or testing of Hydraulic / Electro-Mechanical Systems, Structures, Assemblies and/ or Sub-Assemblies up to the date of publication of this Eol.
- 5.4 The interested Prospective Collaborator should have executed a minimum of three (3) Supply Order / Contract Order for repair and/or installation of electro-hydraulic equipment /structures/ assemblies/ sub-assemblies onboard Indian Naval Ships and Submarines within the last 5 years from the date of publication of this Eol. A list of documentary proof consisting of Supply Order / Contract Order along with its satisfactory completion certificate or certification by the client about the work executed should be submitted.
- 5.5 The interested Prospective Collaborator should have executed **Supply Order(s)**/ Contract Order(s) for major repair and/or turnkey installation of Arresting Gear onboard an Indian Naval Aircraft Carrier within the last 7 years from the date of publication of this EoI (the total contract value of executed works should not be less than Rs 10 Cr). A list of documentary proof consisting of Supply Order / Contract Order, along with its satisfactory completion certificate or certification by the client about the work executed should be submitted.
- 5.6 The interested Prospective Collaborator should have a tie-up with reputed Indian/ Foreign experts or design agency to assist BEML in the validation of the design of Arresting Gear. The aforesaid reputed expert/ agency should have experience in the design of similar equipment. A proof of the tie-up and a copy of the Design Agency's





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Supply Order / Contract Order along with a work completion certificate of having designed similar equipment is to be submitted for verification by BEML.

- 5.7 The interested Prospective Collaborator shall accept/agree that BEML shall have the sole right to market the product in India for MoD/DRDO/CSIR/ DPSU's/ Military/MHA and also shall export on mutual consent.
- 5.8 The interested Prospective Collaborator shall accept to become the MRO partner to undertake all activities related to the maintenance, overhaul, and upgrade of the equipment on-site pan-India, as per the project requirements, abiding by the workshare agreements to be made subsequently.
- 5.9 The interested Prospective Collaborator shall agree that BEML will be entitled to hold Intellectual Property Rights (IPR) in respect of all products/ technologies developed under this EoI.
- 5.10 Lack of complete information/furnishing of false information related to work carried out / documents submitted will lead to disqualification of the Prospective Collaborator.
- 5.11 The interested Prospective Collaborator shall fill the required fields & submit the Eligibility Criteria while responding to this EoI enclosed at *Annexure-2* with supporting document/ certificate/ undertaking letter wherever applicable.





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#### **SECTION - 6**

#### **GENERAL TERMS & CONDITIONS**

- 6.1 This Eol document is for Strategic Tie-up / long-term business collaboration with a suitable Prospective Collaborator for design, design validation, development, manufacture, testing, installation, and commissioning including sea trials and aftersales Sea Borne Aircraft Arresting Gear and other electro-hydraulic equipment such as Aircraft Restraining Gear, Missile / Torpedo Launchers, Ship / Submarine based Masts, Aircraft Lifts on Ship Decks, land and ship-based Aircraft Arrester Barrier Systems, etc. for Indian Naval Ships and Submarines or any other cusotmers, does not have any relation to any of the previous Eol / RFI / RFP floated for similar activities.
- 6.2 This EoI document is not an offer and is issued with no commitment. BEML reserves the right to Revise/withdraw/Cancel the EoI or change or modify full or any part thereof at any stage.
- 6.3 BEML also reserves the sole right and discretion to disqualify Prospective Collaborator, should it be so necessary at any stage.
- 6.4 Timeline and sequence of events resulting from this EoI shall ultimately be determined by BEML.
- 6.5 By submitting response to this EoI, the Prospective Collaborator shall deemed to be acknowledged that it has carefully read all the terms & conditions of this EoI document, and has fully understood/informed himself/herself as to all existing terms and conditions.
- 6.6 The interested Prospective Collaborator shall compulsorily fill up the following to this EoI document, along with all supporting documents.
  - (a) Company Details as per Annexure-1.
  - (b) Compliance with Eligibility Criteria as per *Annexure-2*
- 6.7 The response shall necessarily be accompanied by the following details: -
  - (a) Prospective Collaborator's profile with the Management structure and Group information, if any.
  - (b) Product Profile.





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- (c) Product Technical details
  - (i) Reference list of customers.
  - (ii) Annual Audited financial reports for the last three (03) Financial years.
  - (iii) Any other information that is relevant to the business and requirement of BEML and would make the **interested** Prospective Collaborator relevant for a long-term mutually beneficial relationship.
- 6.8 The **interested** Prospective Collaborator shall abide by the terms & conditions of this EoI. [Please Note that this is a fundamental condition of this EoI document and must be well understood and accepted by the interested Prospective Collaborator before participating in the EoI].
- 6.9 The person signing the response to the EoI should have due written authorization **the** Prospective Collaborator to sign the documents and should duly authenticate any errors or corrections in the EoI. Overwriting should be avoided. All pages of the response against this EoI shall be duly signed by the authorized signatory. Copies of the credentials/ documents that are to be annexed must be self-attested and bear the signature and seal of the authorized signatory / authorized representative of the interested Prospective Collaborator. The interested Prospective Collaborator will be requested to produce the originals of all information/ documents as and when so required by BEML.
- 6.10 Multiple proposals from the same interested Prospective Collaborator should not be submitted.
- 6.11 BEML at its discretion shall inspect the interested Prospective Collaborator's works/office/reference site premises for evaluation, as deemed necessary before the selection of the Prospective Collaborator. BEML's decision in this regard shall be final.
- 6.12 Any interested Prospective Collaborator which has been declared insolvent, bankrupted, debarred /banned/ blacklisted by Central/State Governments of India or by any entity controlled by Central/State Governments of India, and continues as on the date of submission of EoI, shall not be eligible to submit the EoI.
- 6.13 BEML shall receive responses pursuant to this EoI in accordance with the terms set forth herein, as may be modified, altered, amended, and clarified from time to time by BEML and all responses shall be submitted in accordance with such terms on or before the date specified in this EoI for submission of responses.
- 6.14 The EoI and all correspondences and documents related to the EoI response shall be in the English language, provided that any printed literature/document





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furnished by the Prospective Collaborator may be written in another language, as long as such literature is accompanied by a translation of its pertinent passages in the English language in which case, for purposes of interpretation of the bid, the English translation shall govern. Provided that in case the English translation is found to be incorrect at a later stage, BEML will have right to take appropriate action against the Prospective Collaborator as may be deemed fit.

- 6.15 The Selected Prospective Collaborator should not subcontract the work related to the agreed scope of work without prior written approval from BEML.
- 6.16 The Selected Prospective Collaborator shall provide the number of resources available required for the development of the work during different phases with necessary technical capabilities.
- 6.17 The personnel of Selected Prospective Collaborator must adhere to all the safety guidelines while handling/ manufacturing equipment, machinery, components etc. All the safety gadgets procurement and issue shall be within the scope of work and responsibility of the Selected Prospective Collaborator.
- 6.18 **Governing Laws & Jurisdiction**: The Eol process shall be governed by, and construed in accordance with the laws of Republic of India. This Eol subject to shall be subject to exclusive jurisdiction of the Courts at Bengaluru (India).
- 6.19 The terms and conditions as stated in this EoI document are not exhaustive and BEML reserves the right to add, delete, or modify any terms and conditions in the **RFP** to be issued to the short-listed Parties.

#### 6.20 Evaluation & Selection:

- 6.20.1 Upon receipt of response(s) against this EoI, BEML will review the responses, shortlist the Prospective Collaborator, and call the shortlisted Prospective Collaborator (s) for a presentation.
- 6.20.2 BEML intends to shortlist Prospective Collaborator(s), who shall collaborate with BEML on an equipment wise approach for design validation, development, manufacture, testing, installation, commissioning including sea trials and after sales service of Sea Borne Aircraft Arresting Gear and other electro-hydraulic equipment such as Aircraft Restraining Gear, Missile / Torpedo Launchers, Ship / Submarine based Masts, Aircraft Lifts on Ship Decks, land and ship-based Aircraft Arrester Barrier Systems, etc. for Indian Naval Ships and Submarines or any other customer.





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- 6.20.3 Post selection, BEML and the selected Prospective Collaborator shall execute a Non-Disclosure Agreement & also sign an Agreement detailing the roles and responsibilities of Parties, time-lines, exclusivity, indemnification, non-compete, financials, etc on a case-to-case basis.
- 6.21 **Rejection**: An Expression of Interest is liable to be rejected for any of the following conditions:
  - 6.21.1 The Expression of Interest is not accompanied by required documentation and has failed to provide clarifications related thereto- when sought by BEML.
  - 6.21.2 Misrepresentation, lack of proper documentation, fraud, coercion, undue influence, canvassing, etc.
  - 6.21.3 The Expression of Interest is received after the closing time and date. If any information that would have entitled BEML to reject or disqualify the applicant becomes known after the applicant has been qualified, it reserves the right to reject the applicant at that time or at any time after such information becomes known to BEML.

The prospective Collaborator should agree to sign the "Integrity Pact" with BEML committing the persons/officials of both parties, not to exercise any corrupt influence on any aspect of the joint working / future contract in the Format provided by BEML
